In the 2008-09 school year the Diocese funded more than 5,300 scholarships in 120 schools.

These scholarships, totaling more than \$5.8 MM, are made possible through the collaborative efforts of the Alive in Hope Foundation, the Annual Catholic Appeal and Futures in Education. We look forward to funding even more students in 2009-10!

DOB Scholarship Program

Funding sources: Alive in Hope Foundation, Annual Catholic Appeal and Futures in Education

- Financial aid to students enrolled in Catholic schools in Brooklyn and Queens
- Applications are posted on First Class in a PDF, also available at www.psas.org
- First round due date is March 15, applications are accepted on a rolling basis
- Typically four rounds of funding, families are notified by PSAS – a letter comes to their houses signed by the Bishop
- Scholarships range from \$500 to \$1,400
- Families must reapply annually
- School receives the check from Futures in Education at the Award Ceremony in October

Be An Angel to a Student

Funding sources: FIE Angels and Alive in Hope

- Sponsorship program where one donor, an "Angel", helps pay part of the tuition for a student in need
- Principal identifies families in great financial need
- Students must send letters and report cards to Futures Office throughout the school year, see schedule in Futures First Class folder
- Applications available in Futures Folder in First Class, families should also complete a PSAS
- Scholarships are \$1,500
- Checks are distributed by Futures in Education in October, February and June

Bishop's Scholarship Program

Funding Sources: Alive in Hope Foundation, Annual Catholic Appeal, Children's Scholarship Fund, Futures in Education

- Financial aid for children coming from a non-Catholic school or those in Catholic school entering kindergarten
- Those with scholarships must complete requalification paperwork annually
- Applications are distributed in March/April through First Class, also available at www.scholarshipfund.org
- Scholarships range from \$500 to \$2,100
- Schools receive checks from Children's Scholarship Program in November and March
